

# **2020 Guide for The Arc of Essex County's Camp Hope Registration and Application Process**

Thank you for your interest in Camp Hope. The Arc of Essex County's Camp Hope Program has been providing summer camp experiences for children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities for over 60 years!! Camp Hope provides traditional camp activities including supervised swimming and outdoor fun with modified sports, arts & crafts, and music. While enjoying these activities, attention to skill development is provided in the areas of daily living skills, peer interaction, socialization skills, and developing appropriate behaviors. Our goal is for each camper to have a camp experience filled with fun, socialization, and incorporate some education along the way...

## **2020 CAMP SEASON DATES**

The 2020 Camp Hope season will begin on Monday, June 29, 2020 and ending on Friday, August 14, 2020. The hours of operation are 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

## **CAMP SERVICES**

#### TRADITIONAL CAMP SERVICES

For each week of camp, campers are assigned a group based on age. Staff support for each group is generally determined by the age mix of each group. For the 2020 Camp Hope Season, in addition to a group leader assigned to each camper group, we anticipate the staff to camper ratios as follows:

- Age 5 through 12: 1 staff for every 3 campers;
- Age 13 through 20: 1 staff for every 5 campers;
- Age 21 and over: 1 staff for every 6 campers.

Additional supports for the overall Camp Hope program include a manager, assistant manager, on site full time health professional, specialists in various activities, certified life guards, and behavioral supports.

#### ONE-TO-ONE SERVICES

One to one staff support is available for campers whose needs are determined to exceed the assigned staff-to-camper ratio. If it is determined that your camper meets the criteria for this support, please note that we have a limited amount of staff available and there is an additional fee for this support.

#### TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

Curb-to-curb transportation to and from camp is available for an additional fee for those who live in Essex County.

#### ESY SUMMER DAY PROGRAM

In addition to the traditional camp experience, The Arc of Essex County offers the **ESY Summer Day Program at Camp Hope**. This program is supervised by a certified special education teacher and includes an academic period as well as an academic themed approach to the camp day to enhance the camper's knowledge of their environment. Each day, in addition to the academic component, children participate in art class, nature class, adaptive physical education, swimming, and music appreciation. If you are interested in the ESY Summer Day Program at Camp Hope as your child's extended school year program, you must contact your school district's child study team to request this program. Upon agreement, please have your district complete the School District Response Form and return it to The Arc of Essex County immediately. Please see the Tuition and Funding information for more details.

## **REGISTRATION FEE AND FORM**

A Registration Fee and Registration Form is required to secure your camper's spot at Camp Hope. Registration is accepted on a rolling basis until all spots are filled. Do not hesitate to register to ensure participation.

- <u>Registration Fee:</u> Registration for Camp Hope is \$40.00 which includes enrollment as a member of The Arc of Essex County, quarterly newsletters about The Arc of Essex County, and a camp T-shirt to be given out on your camper's first day. The Registration Fee is non-refundable unless your child is not accepted to the camp for any reason.

## **NEW CAMPER INTAKE**

All new campers are required to participate in a face to face intake with a member from our Camp Hope team. Upon receipt of the camper application, a member of the Camp Hope team will reach out to schedule an intake. 

# **Tuition and Funding Information 2020**

Parents/guardians of campers accepted into the Camp Hope program will be sent an invoice for services. Payment is required before the start of the camp season, unless other payment arrangements have been made through DCF, DDD, the School District, or through approved Financial Aid assistance from The Arc of Essex County.

## **Registration Fee:**

Due with Registration Form (applies to all campers regardless of funding source)

One camper - \$40.00 due with application

Two campers - \$55.00 due with application

\*\*Additional Fee for XXL or XXXL shirt - \$3.00

## **Camp Hope Tuition fees:**

Parent/Family (applies to campers with no DDD, DCF, School District funding support or for additional weeks):

#### **Camper Tuition Fees**

Week 1 = \$320.00/week Weeks 2 – 7 = \$400/week

weeks 2 - 7 = \$400/wee

**One-to-One Fees** 

Week 1 = \$640.00

Weeks 2 - 7 = \$800.00/week

Transportation Fee (only available for campers that reside in Essex County)

Week 1 = \$160.00/week

Weeks 2 - 7 = \$200.00/week

#### Campers up to age 21:

<u>DCF:</u> The Arc of Essex County's Camp Hope program is an approved provider of camp services though the Department of Children and Families (DCF), PerformCare. DCF will provide funding for up to \$80 per day for camp services and one-to-one support for those deemed eligible. The steps below will help access PerformCare/DCF funding:

### Traditional Camp Support

1. Complete the PerformCare Application for Financial Support toward Summer Camp Tuition. (Note: As of 2/1/2020, these are not yet posted on the PerformCare website, but please check www.performcarenj.org frequently to see when the application is posted). Once the application is posted, it can be printed out from the DCF website or by calling PerformCare at 1-877-652-7624 to have a copy mailed.

- 2. Attach a copy of Camp Hope's Registration Form. **DO NOT** mail DCF the entire Camp Hope application.
- One-to-one funding through PerformCare/DCF —If you are requesting one-to-one funding from DCF a separate application can be found on the PerformCare website or by calling the number listed on page one.

Once the completed DCF "camp packet" is received by PerformCare/DCF, applications will be processed by DCF on a rolling basis. When a determination regarding eligibility for DCF camp financial support has been made, PerformCare will provide written notification of the outcome (approval/authorization, denial because eligibility criteria are not met, denial due to lack of resources) to the family and Camp Hope.

<u>School Districts:</u> Your child's school district may approve funding for your camper to attend Camp Hope through the ESY component of your child's educational programming. If you are interested in having your child's school district pay for Camp Hope, complete the enclosed School District Agreement Form.

**ESY Camper Tuition Fees with summer program:** \$120.00 per day **ESY One-to-One Fees with summer program:** \$220.00 per day

ESY Transportation Fee: \$40.00 per day

#### Campers age 21 and over:

<u>DDD:</u> Division of Developmental Disabilities – for campers over the age of 21 or youth enrolled on the CCW or Supports Program Waivers – note DDD does not cover 1 to 1 support

**Camper Tuition Fees:** \$118.01 per unit (1 unit Respite/Camp = 1 day of camp)


Transportation Fee: \$0.74 per mile (from camper's house to Camp Hope – 127 Cedar Street, East Hanover, NJ)

The Arc of Essex County is an approved provider of camp services through the DDD Supports Program and CCW. Contact your support coordinator to request that this service be added to your ISP. If your family member is not enrolled on the CCW or Supports Program Waivers, please contact DDD.
